Mzi Nduna (PhD) is the Divisional Executive: Research Impact Division at the HSRC. Mzi has 29 years of work experience, 17 of which were spent in the University sector. She is the former Dean of Health Sciences at the University of Fort Hare and a former Head of School at WITS University. Among others, Mzi started and led the [Net 10](#), and FACT research groups consisting of researchers from Southern Africa Development Community (SADC) universities. Mzi has consulted on climate justice and gender, decolonial feminist approaches, gender mainstreaming, sexual harassment, gender political economy analysis (GPEA), and has conducted several end-term evaluations (ETE). Mzi's research output includes 69 peer reviewed journal articles, 3 books, 4 special issue journals, 8 book chapters, and several research reports. On Google Scholar, [Mzi](#) has 7720 citations and an H-index of 33. Dr Nduna was a Carnegie Fellow hosted at the University of Alberta, Canada. She is also a Fellow of the Africa Regional Sexuality Leadership Centre in Lagos, Nigeria,
